The 7th Community Day was held on 8th June. The heart of Ledbury was filled with families and visitors going to halls and venues shown on the map in the brochure. By using the Master's House, Market House, St Katherines Hall, Burgage, Community Hall, Bowling Club, Recreation Park, Children's Centre, Fire Station, Youth Drop-in Centre, Church Lane, St Michaels Church and The Homend Mall there becomes quite a throng of activity spread around for the entire 4 hours. The Participants have recently been asked for feedback about the Community Day with early responses being fully supportive of the event and wishing it to run next year.

The Administration of Ledbury Community Day is managed by the Committee to make it as open to all the various groups, societies, agencies and local services that have an interest in Ledbury. The number of Participants this year was the same as last year at 80 but there are over 140 entries on our database.
