Chairmans Report

The 3rd Community Day was held on 6th June this year, using the same format as previous years, namely, on a Saturday early in June when there are no holidays for the schools.

This delivered an excellent turnout of residents wishing to see the offerings of 75 local organisations, up on last years total of 65.

The feedback from our Participants have been favourable, citing no issues and requesting the event to be repeated in 2016. The committee have since agreed to hold the next event on Saturday 11th June 2016.

The Burgage and St Katherine's halls were at maximum capacity with stalls and the committee will be mindful of space when planning for 2016 if any more Participants wish to join. The Community Hall has been held as a reserve space in case of bad weather, which fortunately did not arise this year.

The sponsors that help support the costs of the Day were Heineken who again undertook to print 2500 brochures, Ledbury Town Council who gave £200 and Westons of Much Marcle who gave £150. Income & Expenses for the Day are given in the Treasurers Report.

Many thanks must go to the small team of volunteers that make up the Committee who give their time to contacting Participants, compiling the notes for the brochures, allocating stalls to the booked halls and supervising the whole show on the day.
